### Bedwyr Williams

#### Tyrrau Mawr ac Artist Hŷn

Yn ystod yr haf yma rydym yn falch iawn o gyflwyno gwaith gan yr artist Bedwyr Williams. Mae ei ffilm, **Tyrrau Mawr** ar fenthys i Blas Glyn y Weddw gan Amgueddfa Cymru fel rhan o gynllun newydd Oriel Celf Gyfoes Genedlaethol i Gymru. Arddangosir hefyd gasgliad o baentiadau a darluniau o'i waith diweddar, **Artist Hŷn**.

Mae Bedwyr Williams, sydd yn byw yn lleol yng Ngwynedd, yn artist llwyddiannus ac amlwg, sy'n cael ei gydnabod yn rhyngwladol am ei waith amlddisgyblaethol gan gynnwys fideo, perfformiadau, barddoniaeth, cerflunwaith, peintio a darlunio. Gan ddefnyddio dychan ac arsylwi digrif, mae ei waith yn ymwneud â phobl, cymdeithas a hynodion bywyd.

#### Tyrrau Mawr

Ar lethrau Cader Idris yn Eryri, o amgylch glannau Llyn Cau, saif 'dinas fega' newydd yn y dyfodol. Wrth i ni edrych allan ar yr olygfa, mae'r dydd yn newid i fod yn nos gan gyd-fynd â thrac sain a throslais. Wedi'u hysgrifennu a'u hadrodd gan yr artist, cawn straeon am ffuriant y ddinas a dyhead ei phensaer.

Mae'r gwaith yn mynd a thraddodiad tirluniau Richard Wilson o'r 18fed ganrif i'r eithaf trwy ei ddarlun o ddyfodol nad yw mor bell i ffwrdd. Yn **Tyrrau Mawr**, mae Williams yn dod â threfoli cyfoes a pheirianneg gymdeithasol sy'n gysylltiedig â dinasoedd newydd eu ffurio i ogledd

Cymru. O ffotograffau o dirluniau Eryri, mae'n dychmygu ac yn crefftio prosiect pensaerniol.

Mae ansawdd craff y ffilm yn cael ei greu o ddelweddau llonydd ansawdd uchel a dynnwyd o'r mynydd gan yr artist ochr yn ochr ag adeiladau wedi'u modelu, eu lleoli, a'u goleuo i ddangos treigl amser yn ystod dydd a nos. Bu Williams yn gweithio gyda Bait Studio yng Nghaerdydd i 'bwytho' y rhain at ei gilydd i greu 'paentiad matte', wedi'i wneud i deimlo fel dehongliad peintiwr yn hytrach na llun llonydd.

### **Artist Hŷn**

Mae Artist Hŷn yn cynnwys casgliad o waith diweddar gan gynnwys blychau golau, paentiadau a darluniau y mae Williams wedi bod yn eu datblygu dros y blynnyddoedd diwethaf. Gan osod drych i'r byd celf, mae'r gwaith yn cynnwys brasluniau'r artist o fywydau mewnol ac allanol lle mae'n delweddu deialogau mewnol a chyfnewid rhyngbersonol yn fanwl gywir ac yn ingol.

Mae Williams yn tynnu ei sylw ei hun a'n sylw ninnau at drigolion byd celf hirsefydlog, wedi'u tynnu neu eu paentio o fewn yr ystafelloedd gwyn llachar y maent wedi gweithio, siarad, cymdeithasu a chael canmoliaeth ynddynt; lle maent wedi dal grym a dylanwad. Mae'n mireinio nodweddion arbennig hunan-gyflwyniad, y ddau wedi'u byw a'u dal trwy lwyfannau cyfryngau cymdeithasol: cnawd gwelw ffêr noeth rhwng hem yr esgid a'r trowsus; silwétt penodol gwisg a ddewiswyd yn ofalus; mae'r trwyndlws yn pefrio a'r artist nad yw, rydych yn synhwyro, yn eich hoffi, yn rhythu arnoch.

Mae'r paentiadau wedi'u trefnu fel portreadau teulu mewn plasty. Mae testunau'r gweithiau hyn yn gwyro rhwng bywiol gyfarwydd a rhyfedd na ellir eu lleoli, o wynebau niwlog, tryloyw gyda llygaid miniog, clir, i draed di-hoc mewn esgidiau du Rhydychen neu glociau Birkenstock Boston. Mae portreadau yn amlygu olion gwan o linellau, gwythiennau gweladwy o dan groen 'gauzy', arwyddion o heneiddio a bregusrwydd, yn amlwg iawn o dan oleuadau oriel llachar.

## **PRESS RELEASE**

### **Tyrrau Mawr & Older Artist**

This summer we are delighted to present work by artist Bedwyr Williams. His film, **Tyrrau Mawr** is on loan to Plas Glyn y Weddw from the National Collection at Amgueddfa Cymru - Museum Wales as part of the newly formed National Contemporary Art Gallery Wales initiative. Also exhibited are a collection of paintings and drawings from the artist's recent body of work, **Older Artist**.

Bedwyr Williams, based locally in Gwynedd, is a successful and prominent artist, internationally recognised for his multi-disciplinary work across video, performance, poetry, sculpture, painting and drawing. Using satire and comic observation, his work is about people, society and life's peculiarities.

#### **Tyrrau Mawr**

On the slopes of Cader Idris in Eryri, around the banks of Llyn Cau, sits a futuristic new mega city. As we look out onto the view, it changes from day to night and is accompanied by a soundtrack and voiceover. Written and narrated by the artist, we are told stories of the city's formation and the ambition of its architect.

The work takes the tradition of Richard Wilson's 18th century landscape painting to the extreme through its depiction of a not-so-distant future. In **Tyrrau Mawr**, translating as the Great Towers, Williams brings contemporary urbanisation and social engineering associated with newly-formed cities to North Wales. From photographs of Snowdonia's landscapes, he imagines and crafts an architectural project.

The film's sharp quality is created from high resolution still images taken of the mountain by the artist alongside buildings modelled, positioned and lit to show the passage of time across day and night. Williams worked with Bait Studio in Cardiff to 'stitch' these together to create a 'matte painting', made to feel like a painter's interpretation rather than a captured still.

### **Older Artist**

**Older Artist** features a collection of recent work including lightboxes, paintings and drawings that Williams has been developing over the past few years. Putting a mirror up to the art world, the work features the artist's sketches of interior and exterior lives where he visualises internal dialogues and interpersonal exchanges with both acerbic and poignant precision.

Williams' draws his and our attention to long-standing art world inhabitants, drawn or painted within the bright white rooms in which they have worked, talked, socialised and received acclaim; where they have held power and influence. He hones in on particularities of self-presentation, both lived and captured through social media platforms: the pale flesh of a bare ankle between shoe and trouser hem; the specific silhouette of a carefully chosen outfit; the glinting nose ring and pointed stare of an artist who, you sense, doesn't like you.

The paintings are arranged like family portraits in a stately home. The subjects of these works veer between vividly familiar and strangely unplaceable, from nebulous, translucent faces with sharp, lucid eyes, to sockless feet in black Oxford shoes or Birkenstock Boston clogs. Portraits expose faint traces of lines, visible veins beneath gauzy skin, signs of ageing and vulnerability, markedly apparent under glaring gallery lighting.

## Artist Biography

Bedwyr Williams (born 1974, St. Asaph, Wales), works across video, installation, drawing, painting, sculpture and performance. Often layering verbal and visual, his practice is characterised by acute and wryly empathetic observation of human behaviour, situations and environments, both physical and psychological. Williams has exhibited widely within the UK and internationally. Upcoming and recent solo shows include Science Fictions, Science Museum, National Collections Centre, Wiltshire, UK (2024); Older Artist, Phillida Reid, London, UK (2023); Do the Little Things, Ancient Connections, Ferns, County Wexford and St Davids Cathedral, Pembrokeshire, UK (2022); THE SEE WALL, East Quay, Watchet, UK (2022); Milquetoast, Southwark Park Galleries, London, touring to Tŷ Pawb, Wrexham, Wales and KARST, Plymouth (2021); Hypercaust / Y Tyrrau Mawr (The Big Towers), Southard Reid, London, UK (2019); ECHT, Tramway, Glasgow International, Scotland (2014) and Fondazione Sandretto Re Rebaudengo, Turin, Italy (2017); The Gulch, Barbican Curve, London, UK (2016); My Bad, IKON, Birmingham, UK (2012).
